

Mini IOP's

In preparation for your IB IOP, we'll complete a series of Mini-IOP's this semester.

- Round 1 – will be in pairs and last between 3-4 minutes a pair
- Round 2 – will be individually and last between 3:30 – 4:30 minutes
- Round 3 – will be individually and last between 5 – 7 minutes

These will be verbal analysis of the story.

In addition, we'll complete 1-2 rounds of visual analysis of a story. (For this, you'll need to find 2-3 symbols from a story and draw a visual representation of the symbol).

After several practice rounds, by the time we begin the actual IB IOP's in April, you'll all be completely prepared to do well!

Details

1. All students in class will complete all three rounds. Students will be picked randomly to present, so you won't know a head of time what day you'll present. If you are absent one or two days, it will not negatively impact your grade, but if you are frequently absent and miss an entire round, you will earn a zero. Students who are out for an extended amount of time with an excuse will see me for an alternative assessment.
2. After each presentation, I will provide an oral critique. This is not meant to embarrass anyone, but rather help the class better understand the requirements. The direct feedback allows for the entire class to understand what went well and what needs improvement.
3. The Mini-IOP's will be a piece of evidence and each new round will replace the old round. Therefore, if you improve with practice (as you should), your grade will improve!
